He told them to get the lessons of the last Bible Camp (which are begun in this newsletter) well learned and into their experience because He wanted to do something new and more glorious than before, Alex and some of the others planned on a time of prayer and fasting prior to Bible Camp. They were expecting a large crowd.

Sebaji & Munggut

In April and May Darto and Jeremia ministered in the village of Sebaji where people were delivered, healed, saved and filled with the Holy Spirit. Father Stube was not with them as he was having a battle with malaria. He joined them shortly, however, (praise the Lord!) and worked with the team in Munggut. Several times during those meetings the Lord would instruct certain people to go out to specific homes where His Word was needed. One example of this was reported by Darto: "At one point the Lord said, 'Go north two kilometers. Enter the house I show you. There you will find a blind person. Preach the Gospel there.' As I heard this prophecy I began to feel something happening inside of me. I prayed, "Lord don't send me, I don't have the faith for it. Send someone else," As I was praying like that in my heart, a teenage girl appeared in front of me, raised her hand and delivered the following words, "My son, do not doubt and fear, I have chosen you for this mission and I will give you the faith for it." After apologizing to the Lord I started off with three teen-age boys that were also to go there. We went north two kilometers, and there were many,

many houses. Somehow we knew which one we had to go into. We said, "Is there a blind person here?" They brought out a young woman who had been blind for several years. We told them about Jesus, prayed for the blind girl, and the whole family accepted the Lord Jesus.

Many of the young people there run into violent opposition at home. Some are stoned, one had all her clothes torn up, but her friends lent her clothes so she could go to the meetings.

And speaking of clothes - I wish to thank the people of Miracle, Ohio for their offering of clothes which were sent on to Indonesia.

Report on Jesus' Retreat House

Jesus' Retreat House which is run by the Colorado branch of The Holy Way has been experiencing a very busy time this summer. A recent letter from Bobbie and Galen Sharp says, "We have been jam-packed this month - more than we've ever had Last night there were fifteen of us sleeping here. (They have their big house divided dormitory-style with toys in one area; girls in another and the Sharp family in another.) Some of the kids are here Just for a night or two but we seem to be getting so many so often. Needless to say we are more crowded than is comfortable but it looks like we'll be here another winter. We haven't received any word from the Lord contrariwise and the landlord hasn't said anything either. We do ask that you could put in the newsletter our prayer request for guidance for us in the matter of a house."

The work of counseling and ministering at the House has become full-time for Galen. The Lord has drawn him apart into prayer and Bible study daily in preparation to meet that day's ministry needs. Bobbie supervises the physical functioning of the house and the five "permanent" young people maintain the grounds, the housework and the cooking besides pitching in to help the young people who come up for counseling.

Report from Timothy in Korea

About three weeks ago we had a letter from Timothy (Kim Young Ook). He tells us that his congregation is fine in the Lord and that they had a very successful summer Bible school for the children. Several of the little children received the Baptism in the Holy Spirit.

He also told of a missionary Journey he took to a village on a island about twelve hours from Seoul. The people on that island had asked him to go some time before; but when the Lord told him to go - he went. This island has no electricity; no cars, etc. but the people are hungry for the Lord and He is there and He meets their hunger. Timothy's ministry opened to them the Good News and many believed and were saved. Many were filled with the Spirit. Now they want to read The Word. They have no Bibles, if you would like to help send them Bibles, please send a gift to The Holy Way and mark it for the Bibles and we will see that Timothy has Bibles for these people.

His letter went on to say then that his wife has TB and he was feeling discouraged and rather defeated by this and the financial burden it placed on him. God is able to meet his needs whether financial or, better yet, by restoring Okkhie, healed, to, her husband's side, in His work and for His glory.

Now follows the first part of the transcript of the Bible Camp held by The Holy Way team in Nongkodjadjar, Indonesia in December, 1970. The lessons taught by the Lord here were to be studied in preparation for the Bible Camp at their new location in Lawang the first week in September, 1971.

Foreword – by Father Stube

From November 30 to December 7, 1970 we held a Bible Camp in Nongkodjadjar with the title, "The Living Word." This was based on Hebrews 4:12 – "The word of God is alive and powerful, and sharper than a two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of Joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart."

In the Bible Camp, the living Word of God operated in an unusual manner, speaking to us continually during the seven days of the Camp with prophecy, teaching, visions, testimonies, singing and praying in the Spirit. The Lord Himself led the meetings, using everyone who was yielded to Him.

Before the Bible Camp began, the Lord spoke to us, telling us not to make any schedule or plan, and not to act on past experience. The Lord provided a new atmosphere and new teaching such as we had never before experienced.

During the Camp the Lord dealt with everything that could interfere with His working freely in our lives. His word cut deeply to eliminate sin, to break our egos, to get rid of all plans and thoughts that were not from Him.

All the proceedings of the Bible Camp were recorded and the following is a translation (slightly abridged) of these recordings.

THE LIVING WORD

1. THE WORD OF THE LORD, DISCERNING THE THOUGHTS AND INTENTS OF THE HEART

The first night the committee had planned to begin with introductions and welcoming of guests. But the Lord had another plan. He began immediately laying out briefly what He intended to do in the Camp.

For the first three days we experienced the power of the living Word, dealing with the hearts of each camper, cleansing and uniting. He said that He was going to

reveal His secrets to us if we would straighten out our lives and form a united fellowship.

Prophecy:

I do not look at your external appearance, but I look at your heart. Humble yourselves and come to Me. I have brought you together so that you can understand My ways. I have gathered you to be taught by My Spirit. I do not want you to be praised by men, but I want you to come humbly before Me.

I want to teach you to overcome in the power of My Word; for My Word has the power to bring victory in your personal life, making you more than conquerors. I will show you the way to persevere to the end and enter My Kingdom.

I will give you a sword to defeat all your enemies.

I will show you how My Word is working in these last days, preparing the way before Me, for I am coming soon. I have called you together on this mountain in preparation for end-time ministry.

Do not proceed according to your own ideas or past experiences or church background, for I wish to show you new ways which will enable you to overcome all difficulties and trials.

I shall teach you and reveal My secrets to you that you may be ready to go forth Into battle. You cannot be victorious through your own strength, only those who walk in My Spirit can enter into My promises. Many in these last days will fall and deny Me and sell My Name for their own gain. But do not you do likewise.

I want you to enter into everlasting life. I have chosen you and ordained you by My Spirit that you may reveal My truth.

In these days I'm preparing and ordaining you for My end-time ministry.

Prepare your hearts to receive My teaching. Straighten out your Personal lives and your relationships with each other. Sanctify yourselves before Me that I may reveal Myself to you.

Teaching: The Word for the Last Days

"The Lord has been speaking to the committee for a few days (before this camp began), telling us not to proceed according to our own natural thinking. The Lord wants to do something new.

So we approach this camp knowing nothing, and leaning solely upon the guidance of the Spirit moment by moment.

If you have come hoping to hear clever preaching, you will be disappointed. But if you come to seek the Lord together, the Lord will surely reveal something wonderful.

The Lord is forming a Body for these last days. We are only a few people, but this is God's plan. Centuries ago Jesus came on earth and gathered twelve men. These men entered into a deep fellowship with Him. The Lord prepared them through this close daily association. The Lord does not always work with many people, but He works deeply.

In these last days the Lord wants to reveal new things to His people. The Word of God is living. He did not only speak in past centuries, but He continues to speak.

The work of harvesting is not the same as sowing. There is a time to sow and a time to reap. We live in critical times in which the Lord is preparing us for His Second Coming.

As grain must be ripened before it is harvested, so also we must be matured spiritually. It is not enough to be born again. It is not enough for the seed of the Word to be sown only. The Word must work in our hearts to bring us to maturity.

We are coming to the time of harvest in which the people of God will be gathered together, broken, ground fine, made into fine flour that can be used for bread.

We approach harvest time and the Lord wants, to use us in the preparation and in gathering Of His harvest.

Other generations did not understand these things. But God wants us to understand. The Lord wants to reveal His end-time-secrets to us by His Spirit. For tile reason we must hear His voice clearly these days. I hope you will be patient to hear His voice.

I believe that as we gather here the Lord will reveal new things to us. He will perfect something in our hearts. This is not theory to be written down, but a living thing to be written in each of our hearts.

Prophecy:

Walk in My holiness and righteousness. Empty your thoughts of all idle thoughts, for your thoughts are not My thoughts and your will is not My will. Look, I stand before the door of your heart and knock. Open your heart to Me. Do not receive My Word with your own thoughts. Surrender your - thoughts to Me, that all the principalities and powers may have no influence over you.

I give you powerful spiritual weapons. I give you the Gifts of My Spirit, so that you will not minister with your own strength and ability, but in the power of My Spirit. You will not speak with your own words, but with My Words which I give you.

But know this, that these weapons that I give you can be misused. I give you My power to enter into battle against your enemies, that the principalities and powers of darkness, the power of sin, and the power of death may be destroyed. I give you My weapons so that you can be victorious in the battle of these last days, conquering the world and establishing My Kingdom.

But My weapons can be misused. You can use them to fight with each other, to criticize and slander. In this case your words will have great power to hurt.

Be careful, therefore. Walk always in My Spirit. Avoid idle talk. Speak only what I give you. Let My word come out of your mouth to comfort, strengthen, and edify your brethren.

Remember that the spiritual weapons I give you, have to be used according to My will.

If you wish to inflate yourself, you surely can; and many people will be pleased with you and follow you. Maybe you will think you are somebody big.

But I look for humble ones who do not seek their own advantage, do not want to inflate themselves. I look for those who will decrease that Jesus may increase.

If you humble yourself and exalt the Lord, many people will not be pleased with you and many will criticize you.

But I say to you that you have become My soldiers and I have given My weapons to you. Use My weapons according to My will, humbling yourself and exalting Jesus.

Prophecy:

I will use you as reapers in My harvest field which is already yellow. Clever, highly educated people often exalt themselves and feel themselves capable. They follow their own thoughts and make rules. But I gather you here to receive My teaching concerning My harvest which is ripening.

I want to teach you to gather and worship Me. I want to use you to deliver My Word. I will not only examine you, but, will also use you to deliver my Word.

You still follow the example and regulations of men. Almost all of My Church is bound by regulations and traditions of men, which have departed from My Word.

This is why I have gathered you here to learn. I wish to use you to change the traditions of men.

I have chosen you to be My warriors, but some of you still do not wear My clothes and weapons. Some have My weapons, but not My clothing; some have My clothing but not My weapons. Unless you have My clothing and My weapons you cannot abide in Me.

Yield your hearts and your thoughts to Me. Walk in My Spirit. To the naked I will give clothing. To those who lack weapons, I will provide. Turn away from the idle things of this world and the wisdom of this world. Turn to Me to receive My provision.

Walk in My Spirit. Do not pay too much attention to your conscience or the voice of your own heart. The heart is a deceiver. Surrender your heart. Yield your thoughts to Me. I will change them all. I will clothe you and give you My whole armour.

2. A NEW SONG

The second day the Lord began to speak about worship in the Spirit; and about holiness and purity of heart that He demands of those who wish to worship and walk in His Spirit.

Prophecy:

One of the weapons I give you is a Trumpet. Know you that trumpets can tear down strongholds.

Trumpets, spiritual songs, and psalms are your provision for battle. I want you to sing psalms. Psalms are not something which you do, or compose yourself, but a cry of the soul full of hope.

Remember that the wall of Jericho fell at the obedience of the trumpeters. Are there things which still bind your hearts, minds, and lives? You cannot set yourselves free. But sing psalms, cry out with your soul. You will be set free from the war within you.

Remember David who cried out from the depths of his soul, and all his sins were forgiven and all his suffering overcome by My power.

You do not use this provision for your warfare because you do not yet understand. I will use another of My children to explain this to you.

Teaching: Psalms

In Ephesians 5:19, we are given the following instructions for worship in the Spirit: "Speaking to each other in psalms and hymns, and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord."

Why does it say: "Speaking to each other with psalms

and hymns and spiritual songs"? And what is the meaning of psalms and spiritual songs?

These are not ordinary songs and hymns such as are found in hymn books. This is singing In the Spirit with "spiritual songs," that is, with words and melody given by the Holy Spirit. In 1 Corinthians 14:15 Paul says: "I will sing with my mind and I will sing in the Spirit." So there are ordinary songs that come from the mind of man, but there are also psalms and singing in the Spirit. If we are full of the Holy Spirit, a new song comes out of our heart.

Obviously these "psalms and spiritual songs" are recommended for all Christian worship. In Ephesians 5:19 Paul recommends "speaking to each other in psalms...." In 1 Cor. 14:26 he says: "When you gather, let each one of you have a psalm...." Psalms and spiritual songs are emphasized for New Testament gatherings.

For this reason we need to understand what psalms are. If we examine the Psalms of David, we find the atmosphere one of praise. In times of joy, David praises the Lord; in times of trouble, David still praises the Lord.

But more than this, the psalms contain deep secrets which are revealed by the Holy Spirit. Paul says that one who prays in a tongue speaks mysteries in the Spirit. Psalms also, as songs of the Spirit, contain mysteries that are revealed by the Spirit.

As Jesus hung on the Cross, He cried out in the words of Psalm 22. As we read this psalm, we see that it relates in detail Christ's suffering on the Cross. In Psalm 23 we read about our Good Shepherd and our life in Him. In Psalm 24 we read about the "ever lasting doors" which must open so that the "King of glory" may come in. We know that the King of glory is the Lord Jesus, and the everlasting doors can be no other than the gates of heaven. Thus these verses are clearly a picture of Jesus' Ascension.

These psalms speak of Jesus and His Kingdom. But we know that the psalms were written over 1000 years before Jesus was born. How did David know these things? Because

David received the anointing of the Holy Spirit when Samuel anointed him king. He received wisdom from God's Spirit. The mysteries of the Kingdom of heaven were revealed in the writings of King David by the Holy Spirit.

The Lord still wants to reveal the mysteries of His Kingdom to us. Jesus spoke continually of the Kingdom of heaven; but He could not finish revealing all its secrets. He said He still has many things to reveal to His followers, but they could not yet receive them. Jesus said, when the Holy Spirit came, He would "lead on into all truth." So it is the Holy Spirit who will continue to reveal God's mysteries.

In his letters, Paul often says there is a mystery which was not formerly revealed, but now is revealed by the Holy Spirit; for instance: "Christ in you, the hope of glory" (Col. 1:27); the mystery of Christ's Resurrection (1 Cor. 15:51); or the mystery of God's grace revealed in the fellowship of His Church (Eph 3:1-10). These mysteries were revealed by the Holy Spirit in the first century after Pentecost. In the first century the Holy Spirit revealed Himself in establishing His Church and setting it in His order.

In these last days the Lord wants to reveal new secrets by His Spirit. Jesus does not change, and the Spirit does not change. But His works and the work of His followers in planting season and harvest time is not the same. Soon the Lord is coming again. His harvest will be gathered into His barns. This is our task, who live in this last generation of this dispensation, to prepare for the task the Lord wishes to reveal new mysteries to us.

One way in which the Lord will reveal His mysteries to us is in psalms.

But psalms do not only reveal the mysteries of the Kingdom, they also reveal the secrets of the human heart. Let us look at Psalm 137. This was written when Israel was in Babylonian captivity, to lament their fate. In verses 8 and 9 the Psalmist says: "O daughter of Babylon, who art to be destroyed; happy shall he be, that rewardeth thee as thou hast served us. Happy shall he be,

that taketh and dasheth thy little ones against the stones." We might think: "How bitter these words are, hardly fit to be spoken by a child of God!" But these words reveal very frankly the hidden feelings of people in captivity in a foreign land. The light of God illuminates a heart that is full of bitterness and discouragement.

Psalm 51 reveals David's sin in having Bathsheba's husband killed and taking her as his wife. King David did not try to cover up his sin or to keep face before his people. His sin and his repentance are wide open to be read by all men even to this day. He humbled himself before God and man. Because of his humility the Lord forgave him, blessed him and established His Kingdom through David.

It is difficult for men to confess frankly what is in their hearts, especially their sins. We say: "Oh, I already confessed it to God and God knows all about it." But we don't want to be honest with men. We want others to think we are better than we really are. We don't want them to know about the anger, jealousy and lust that is hidden in our hearts. We defend ourselves before men, hoping they won't see what is in us.

But if the Holy Spirit works in our hearts and in our fellowship, the secrets of our hearts are revealed. If we want to become children of light, the secrets have to be uncovered. One way to bring out the hidden feelings of our hearts is in psalms. Sometimes we will open our hearts in psalms whose words we understand. 'Sometimes in intercession we can sing in the Spirit and express things we do not understand. In Romans 3:26 Paul says that we do not know how we should pray, but as we pray in the Spirit, the Spirit prays with "groanings too deep for (our) words." The Spirit will work in our hearts as we sing psalms in the Spirit.

I believe if we understand this, we will often experience psalms as we worship in the Spirit. The secrets of our hearts will be opened up and straightened out before the Lord. But we also need hearts that are open before men, that our fellowship may be perfected. If we store up bad feelings in our hearts towards someone,

we can pretend to be friendly, but we really do not have a good relationship with that person. There is no real understanding.

In our meetings we have begun to experience singing in the Spirit. But I believe we have not yet fully experienced what is meant by "psalms and spiritual songs." If we continue to yield to the Spirit's guidance, He will reveal His mysteries to us and our hearts will be open before the Lord and before one another. We shall be one in Christ's love, one Body, one Spirit, one soul. The Lord will straighten out everything in our lives and in our fellowship and He will bring us new teaching for this new age.

Prophecy:

I want you always to be of one heart. Understand the love I have shown you in giving My Body to be broken. I want you to be one in Me, in My love, and in My Spirit. Thus you shall see My glory, and I shall build My Kingdom in your midst. This world will know Me in you. If you are one in Me, you will subject yourselves one to another and walk in humility before Me, as I have given you example. I emptied Myself and became a man as you are, that you might walk in newness of life according to My example. Do not compare yourselves, to one another or regard yourself more highly than others. Compare yourselves with Me, that I may bring you to perfection. It is My intention in these last days to bring all My children together as one. I shall establish My Kingdom among you, and will equip you with My weapons. Understand My will and walk in It.

(After this we partook of the Holy Communion together.)

3. LAYING A FOUNDATION FOR THE CHURCH IN THE LAST DAYS

On the third day the Lord spoke to us about the foundation of the end-time church. Along with this teaching the Lord continued to insist on personal holiness and surrender.

Teaching: The Continuation of the Reformation

In the first century the Holy Spirit showed His way of forming and ordering His churches. These first assemblies are our examples for New Testament practice and order. The churches in Jerusalem and Antioch are the models for our churches. The order of worship in 1 Cor. 14 must become the model for our gatherings. The Lord's method of training His twelve disciples is our model for preparing ministries. The first example in each case becomes the basic pattern and we should not depart from this Biblical teaching.

But we have to admit that men find it difficult to continue in the freedom of the Spirit. In church history we see that each new fellowship tries to begin with guidance of the Spirit, but as time goes on, they become more and more organized and more and more under the regulations and doctrines of man.

In the first century the Holy Spirit Himself set His Church in order. The Spirit spoke in their gatherings with all the gifts of the Spirit. The government of the Church was in the hands of ministries appointed and anointed of the Spirit - apostles, prophets, teachers, etc. There were no denominations or human organizations. The Body of Christ had many members, each with its own function, working together under the direct guidance of the Spirit.

The first thing to be lost was the New Testament ministries. Apostles and prophets began to be replaced by priests, bishops, etc. Less and less freedom was given to the operation of the Holy Spirit. By the third century, Montanus and his followers were regarded heretical

because they still held onto the Gifts of the Spirit and sanctified Christian living. In 325 AD the Council of Nicea established official doctrine. Those who didn't follow it were tracked down, beaten up, and killed. The guidance of the Spirit was replaced by the authority of organization and official doctrine.

In the Fifth and Sixth Centuries many barbarian hordes conquered Rome and overran the whole continent of Europe. Several kings became Christians and commanded all their subjects to become Christian, with the result that many people came into the Church without being converted. As time went on the church became more and more political. Christians no longer lived under grace, but under law.

In the Sixteenth Century reformation began in the Church. Little by little, the Lord began to bring back the truths which had been lost during the Middle Ages. Martin Luther in Germany began to understand and experience Justification by faith. John Calvin in Switzerland emphasized the sovereignty of God, teaching that God controls everything in our lives.

In the 18th Century in England, John Wesley and his followers began to experience and teach entire sanctification. They believed that Christians could be sanctified and live in perfect holiness before the Lord (Heb. 7:25).

Beginning at the beginning of the 20th Century in Los Angeles, and other places, Christians received the Baptism of the Holy Spirit, the gifts of the Spirit, experiencing fellowship in the freedom of the Spirit.

We need to be careful, when we receive new understanding or experiences, not to lose the truth we already have. We still need to be justified by faith. We need practical holiness in our daily lives. We still need the Gifts of the Spirit in our meetings and in our ministries. The Pentecostal movement began among holiness groups, who then experienced the Gifts and guidance of the Spirit. But as time went on the Pentecostal denominations became organized. Often they no longer believe in or practice sanctification, and the Gifts of

the Spirit are rarely in evidence. For this reason the Holy Spirit has begun to work outside the Pentecostal, denominations, among Catholics and Protestants and in interdenominational prayer groups.

The Lord wants us to hold on to all the truths which He has reestablished in His churches. And He wants to teach us new things. The Reformation is not finished yet. One further truth that the Lord wants to reestablish in these last days is divine church order, with the ministries in agreement with Eph. 4:11 and 1 Cor. 12:28.

In Eph. 4:8 we read that when Jesus ascended into heaven, He gave gifts to men. These gifts are enumerated in verse 11: "His gifts were that some should be apostles, some prophets, etc." The Lord wants to give a ministry or function to each member of His Body. If we remember that these ministries are a gift, we will not be proud, but will work together well for the benefit of the whole Body (Rom. 8:20).

Divine order with these ministries is God's plan for bringing His Church to maturity, to prepare it for His harvest and His Coming. We cannot be perfected individually, but only as we work together with all the other ministries as explained in verse 12: "For the equipping of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the building up of the Body of Christ." Only by cooperation among all these ministries can the Lord's Church be built up and strengthened for its work in these last days. We need all these ministries and all of them must work together. "If not, the Body of Christ becomes weak and ineffective.

The purpose of the ministries is explained further in verse 13: "until we all come to unity of the faith and knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ."

Men try many ways to unify the faith of Christians, by councils of churches, world conferences, etc. But each church still holds fast to its own rules and doctrines. Each holds one aspect of the truth and regards as heretical all who are of different opinion. For this reason, it is hard for them to learn from each other.

They can't exchange understanding and supplement one another. This is the sickness of the churches.

At present the Lord likes to gather people in fellowships like this one, in which people from different churches can get together without regard for denomination. In this atmosphere with the guidance of the Holy Spirit we can exchange ideas, and supplement each other's understanding and experiences. We approach unity in the guidance and teaching of the Spirit.

We do not establish doctrine or theories about the Lord and His work; but we know the Lord personally. This is the real meaning of the "knowledge of the Son of God" in verse 13.

Man's experience is too narrow and men's teachings and dogmas limit the Lord. How much better for us to gather and listen to the Lord together. Paul admits that we prophesy and know "in part," but still he recommends that we seek all spiritual gifts, especially prophecy. So let us be patient with one another. If something happens in our meeting that we recognize as imperfect, let us not be afraid or angry, and stop the manifestations of the Spirit. Instead we can minister with humility to the person who is not yet perfect, realizing that we ourselves are not yet perfect. We can all seek the Lord together and approach His perfection together. If we have love we can teach one another. All the ministries can work together and supplement one another. We cannot approach perfection individually, but only in cooperation with others, (if my hand is separated from my body, it cannot write letters while I go to the store. It will just become dead and lifeless.)

Let us study to subject ourselves one to another and work together in love. This is God's way of bringing His people to perfection in these last days.

Prophecy:

See the coldness of My churches. I have a purpose in your lives. I want you to become My lights. Learn from Me. I will give My power to you to restore My churches which have grown cold. Learn from Me how you are to

approach the churches and minister to them.

Prophecy:

Know this, that nothing happens to you apart from My will. But you act according to your own will. You agree with Me in word, but your actions oppose Me. I want your words and actions to become one, that you may become perfect in My Kingdom.

Your time is near. Do not run away from My face. Establish your thoughts and hearts in Me, that you be not destroyed. You will see many of My people fall, and depart from me. But I want you to be faithful, for that is My desire for your lives.

Prophecy:

Many of you want to enter My Kingdom, but do not want to hear My Cross offered Myself on the Cross for the salvation of your soul. Why do you not want to lift up My Cross? Many would like to follow Me, but are afraid to bear My Cross. It is My Cross that will bring you to My eternal Kingdom. You cannot enter without bearing My Cross. Do not run away from My Cross. Behind the Cross is a crown prepared for those who bear the Cross.

Bible Reading:

Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord is risen upon you. For darkness shall cover the earth and deep darkness the peoples; but the Lord will arise upon you. And nations shall come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your rising. Lift up your eyes round about, and see; they all gather together, they come to you, your sons shall come from far, and your daughters shall be carried in the arms (Isaiah 60:1-10).

Vision and Teaching:

Once at a prayer meeting in Magetan, we received a vision which made us very sad. In that vision we saw the Lord Jesus sitting and looking very sad. His body was

full of sickness, with many boils. He explained: "This is the condition of My Church; this is My Body which is sick."

The Lord's churches are sick. I do not refer to any one church or denomination, because of course the Body of Christ is only one in all the world. This Body is sick.

As we prayed in that meeting in Magetan, we began to pray in the Spirit with deep groanings, weeping before the Lord.

We are gathered in a Bible Camp with the title: "The Living and Powerful Word of God." I feel a burden for the Lord's churches which are sick. Why are they sick? Because they are not built on the right foundation. They are built on the traditions of men and not on the Living Word. If we build on the foundation of the Living Word, men will recognize the Lord in His Church as they did in Apostolic days.

At present the Lord's churches do not yet experience perfection. In fact, we rarely hear anyone speak about maturity or Christian perfection, the Bride of Christ, or the Church that is built up according to the New Testament order.

In these last days the Lord wants to reestablish His Church upon the right foundation, that is, the Word of God, Jesus Himself being the cornerstone.

If we wish to build the Lord's Church on the foundation of His living Word which examines our hearts, let us surrender our lives into His hands. Let Him examine us, and test us to the very corners of our hearts. Many people try to examine the Bible or other Word of God. But actually, it is His Word that has to examine us. We should not try to adjust God's Word to our thinking, but our thinking should be examined and adjusted by His Word. Then God's Church can be built on a right foundation.

If we let His Word examine the thoughts and secrets of our hearts, our lives will become the Word of God. "You are a letter from Christ, written not with ink but with the Spirit of the living God" (2 Cor. 3:3). It is

the Word of God in us, not just the written Word, that gives us a new life full of God's power.

Let us build up the Body of Christ. We are members of that Body, unified in the Body, enjoying a living fellowship in the living and powerful Church of God.

In these last days it will become clear who is worshipping God and who is not. There will be just two groups: the people of God and the people of Satan. So we need to build our lives on the living and powerful Word, letting that Word examine the innermost thoughts of our hearts.

If we do not build the church on the right foundation, it will be tread under the feet of the heathen. If we build on the right foundation, our opposition will stumble and fall, and we will experience the living and powerful Church of God.

Praise God!

I realize that this takes a lot of reading – but YUM! what a feast! This is about a third of the transcript. The next "installment" will be sent out in about a month.
